Secondary School Parents Information Evening

After School Activities Programme

The booklets for the ASA programme are being finalized and will go out this week. Parents are reminded that **ALL** students in secondary school must do at least one activity each week unless they have after school commitments that are a good substitute for the ASA programme. If you wish your son or daughter to be exempted from ASA's then please write to me stating the reason.

Year 12 students are strongly encouraged to select the TOEFL/SAT preparation activity that will start on Sept. 1st. This activity is intended for Year 12 only and is part of our A Level Plus programme.

All students are reminded that if they wish to remain at school beyond 3:30pm then they should join an activity rather than simply hang around the main gate area. Students not in an activity and still in school past 3:30 **MUST** remain in the area between the security doors and the gate so that they can be supervised.
