Congratulations to Amarin (Ray) Kraivixien in Form 9B. At the end of July this year, Ray competed in the US Kids Golf Teen World Championships at the home of American golf, Pinehurst in North Carolina along with 125 other 13 year old boys. Ray finished tied in 5th place, jointly scoring two under par with an American player. This is an outstanding achievement in such a large competition and on a course described by Pinehurst as having a back 9 which "is one the most difficult anywhere." This earned Ray a place in the Teen World Cup match between the USA vs. The Rest of the World which the Americans narrowly won by 5 matches to 4.
